- 2 Evaluate the contribution of shipwreck evidence to our understanding of both technology and economic systems in the past. (25 marks)
- 3 Using examples, discuss the different types of craft specialisation that existed in the past and what these suggest about the nature of society. (25 marks)
- 4 Explain the circumstances in which intensification of agricultural production became necessary in societies with which you are familiar and how it was brought about. (25 marks)



The *chinampas* are separated by water, and the houses of the owners, whose names are given in Spanish and Aztec hieroglyphs, are situated on squares of solid ground. Major canals are represented by wavy lines and footprints indicate streets.

Figure 2 Produce of the eastern desert received by Khnumhetep, an Egyptian official from the Twelfth Dynasty




Figure 3 Bronze Age carving of a ploughman from Western Sweden
