0 | 4 How successful was the Tsarist regime in improving the condition of the Russian peasantry in the years 1906 to 1914? *(24 marks)*

Question 3

0 | 5 Explain why General Kornilov attempted a coup in August 1917. *(12 marks)*

and

0 | 6 How far was the success of the Bolshevik revolution of October/November 1917 due to Kerensky's weak leadership of the Provisional Government? *(24 marks)*
