1 (a) Examine the nature of signs with reference to the following **two** signs:

Water into Wine (John 2¹⁻¹¹), **and** The Feeding of the Five Thousand (John 6¹⁻¹⁵).

- (b) 'The signs in John's Gospel show Jesus as the Christ, the Son of God and the giver of life.'
 - (i) With reference to other signs that you have studied in John's Gospel, examine this statement.
 - (ii) Assess the claim that the main purpose of the signs in John's Gospel was to show who Jesus was. (30 marks)
- **2** (a) Examine the nature and significance of discourses with reference to:

'I am the Door of the Sheep' (John 10¹⁻¹⁰), **and** 'I am the Resurrection and the Life' (John 11¹⁻⁴⁴).

- (b) Examine the concept of judgement in John's Gospel, and assess the view that John's Gospel is more concerned with present salvation than with future judgement. (30 marks)
- 3 (a) Examine what can be learnt about the person and work of Jesus from John's Passion narrative. (20 marks)
 - (b) Outline John's teaching on the work of the Paraclete, and assess how far you agree with the claim that the Paraclete is Jesus returned. (30 marks)
