0 2 'The ontological argument has no value for the non-believer.'
Assess this view. (20 marks)

Question 2 Religious language

0 3 Explain what it means to say that religious language is:
• non-cognitive
• symbolic. (30 marks)

and

0 4 'It is not possible to talk meaningfully about God.'
Evaluate this claim. (20 marks)

Question 3 Body, soul and personal identity

0 5 'I shall survive the death of my body.'
Analyse the meaning of this statement. (30 marks)

and

0 6 'There are no reasonable grounds for belief in the existence of a soul.'
How far do you agree? (20 marks)

Question 4 The problem of evil

0 7 Explain the free will defence and examine its purpose. (30 marks)

and

0 8 How far is free will a satisfactory explanation for the existence of evil in a world created by God? (20 marks)
