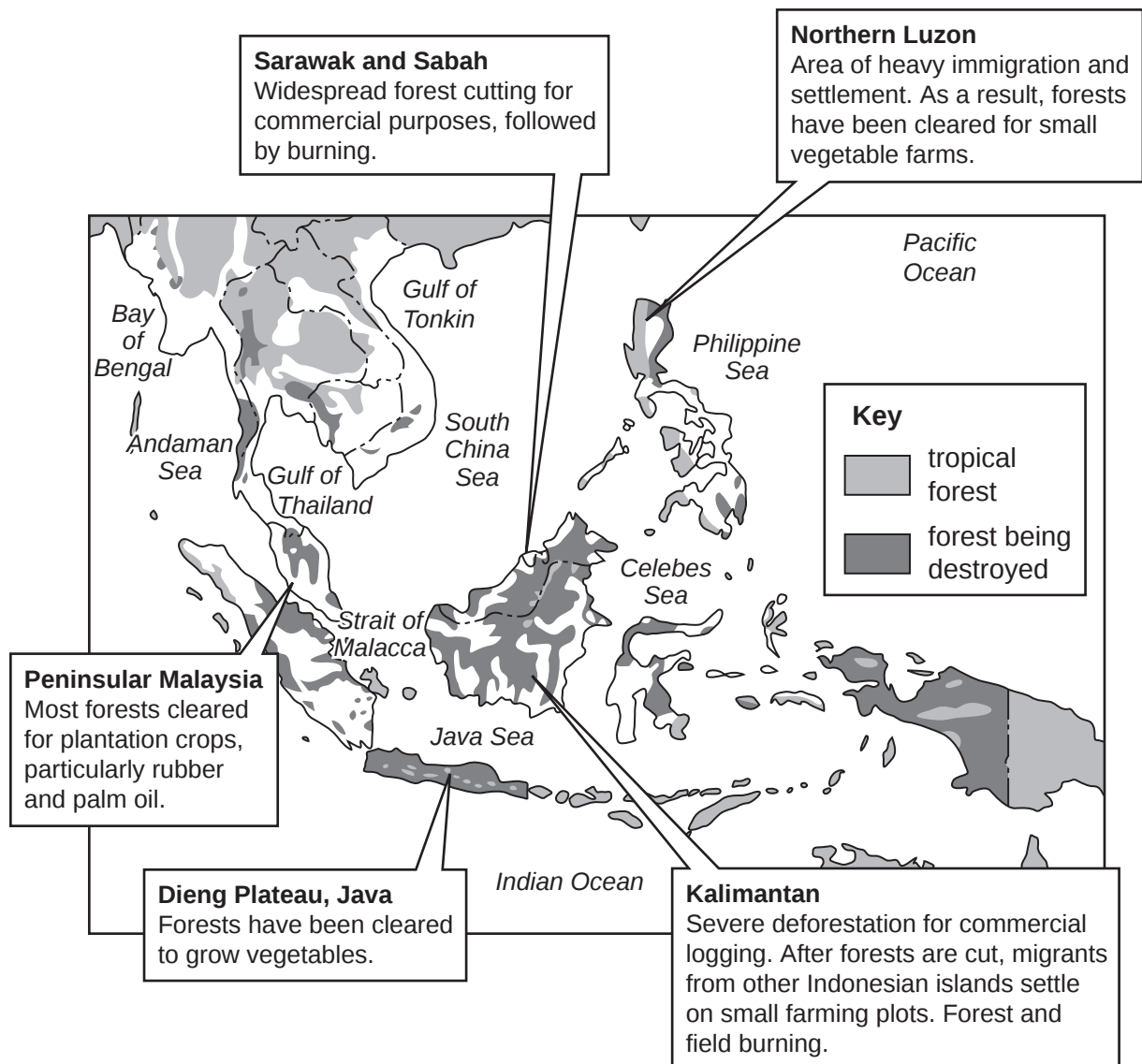

Features of a sand and shingle beach

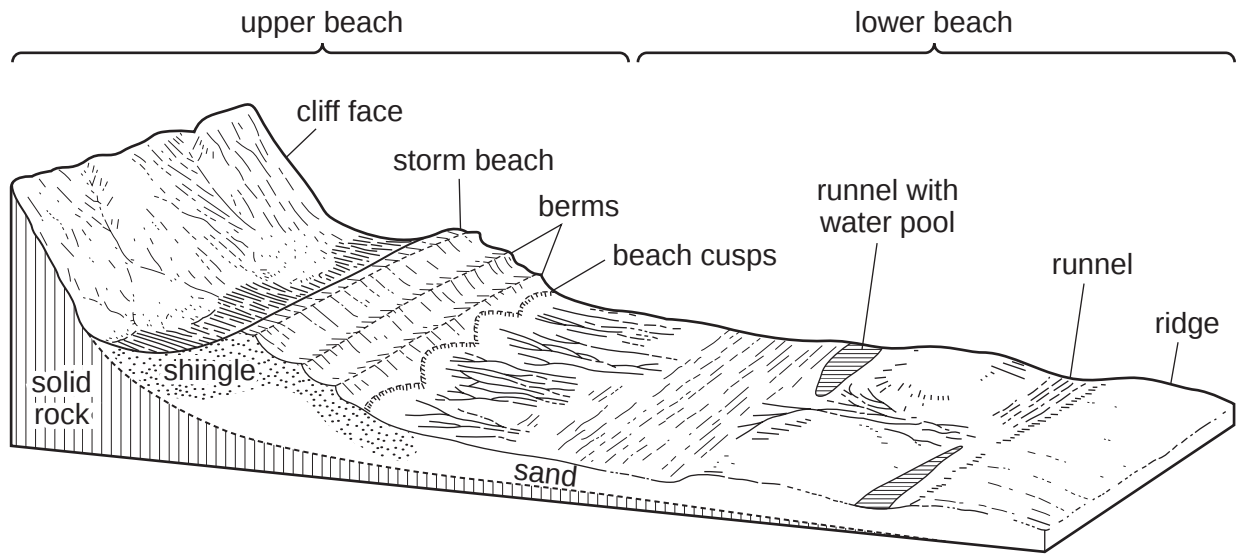

Development of a tornado

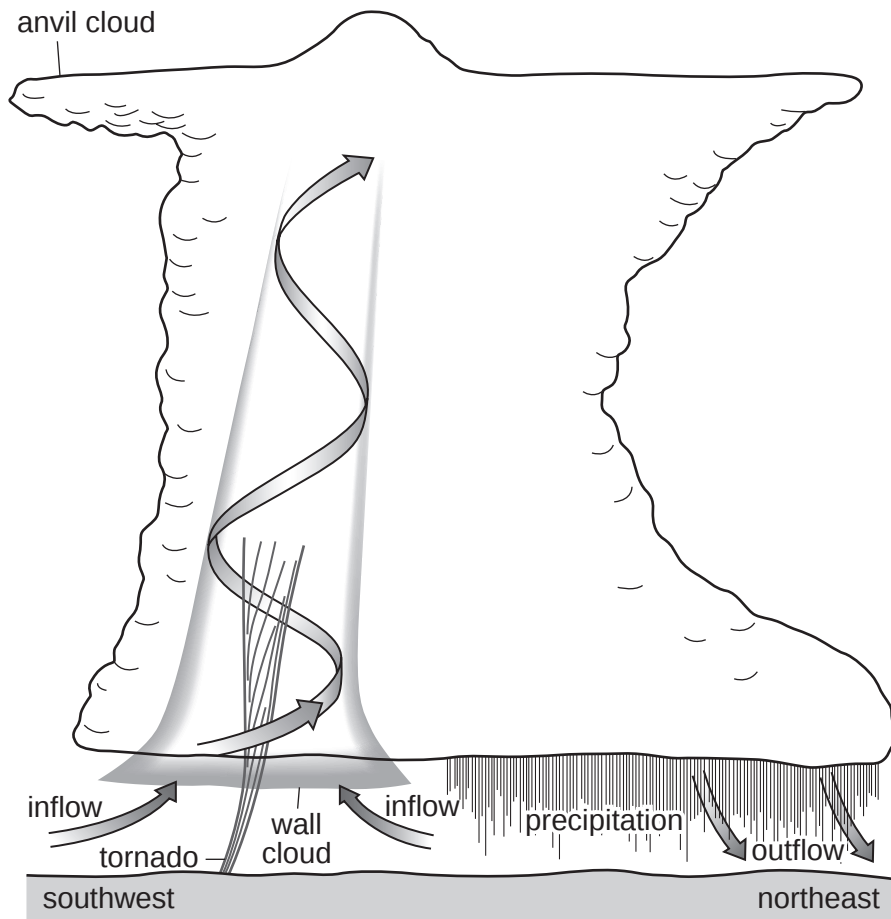
