## A storm hydrograph and characteristics of that drainage basin

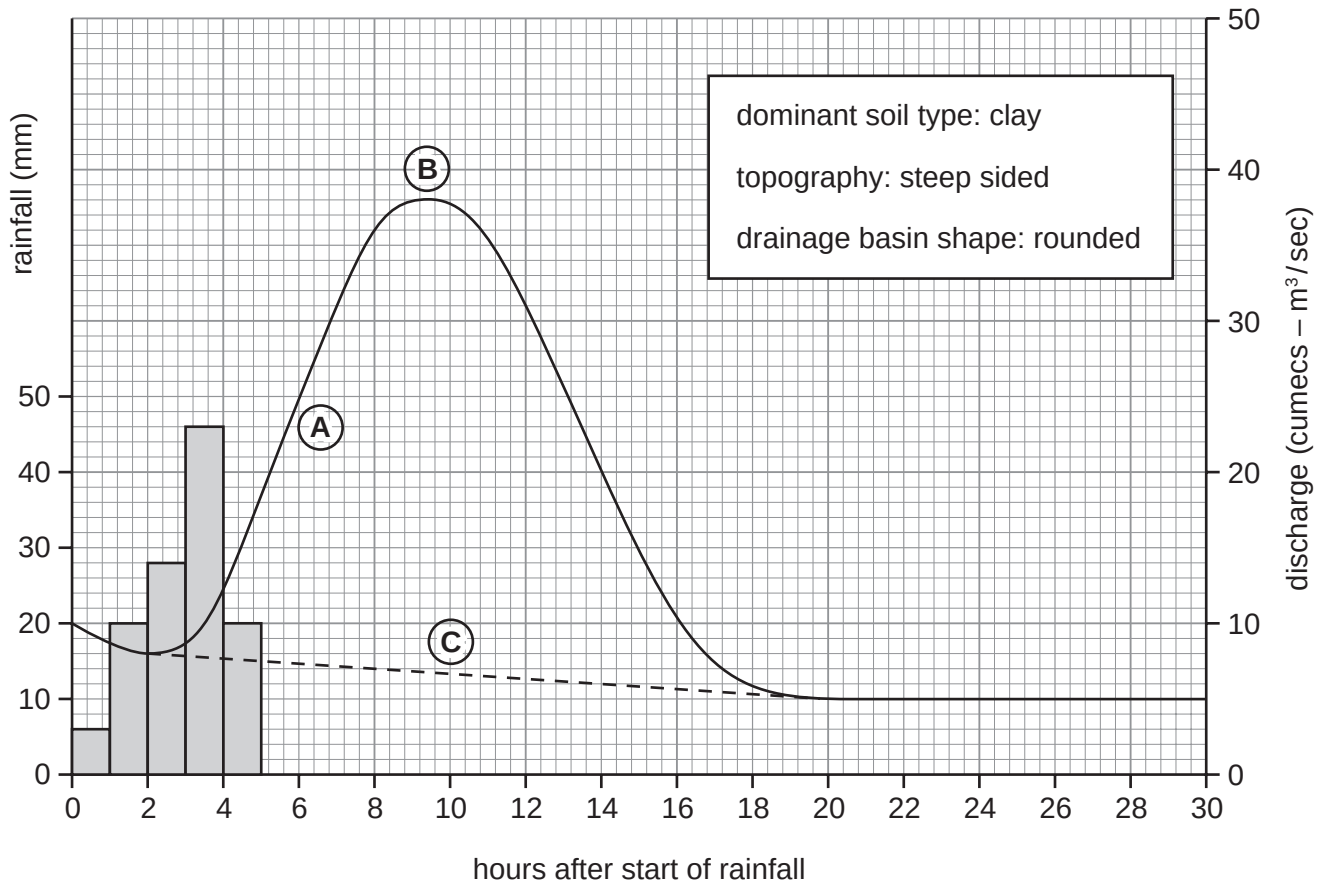

An idealised global pattern of pressure and winds

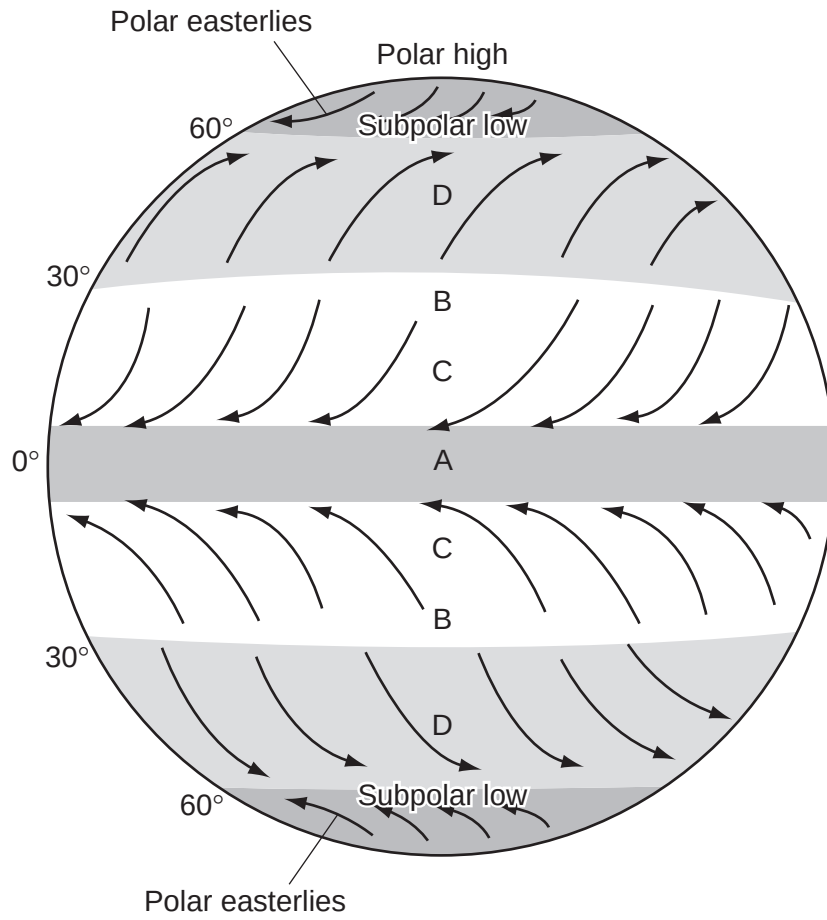

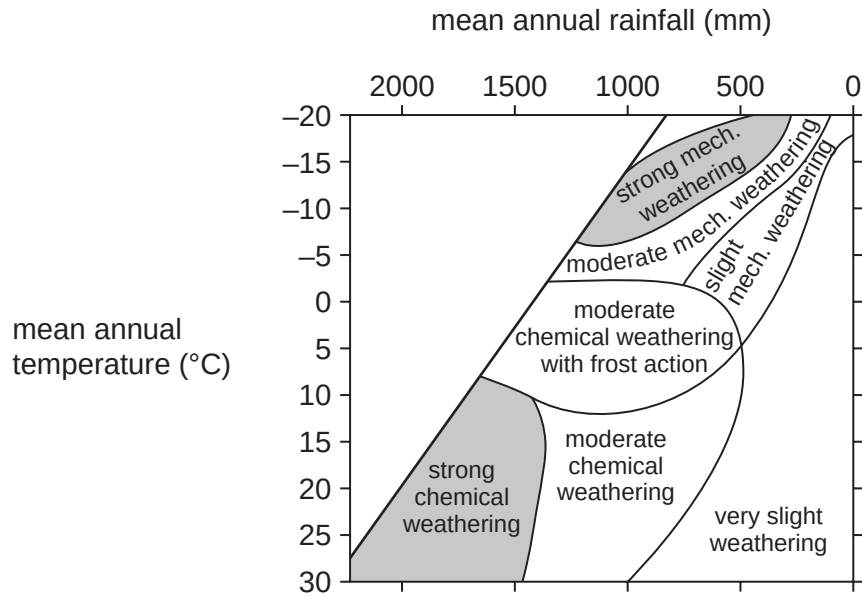


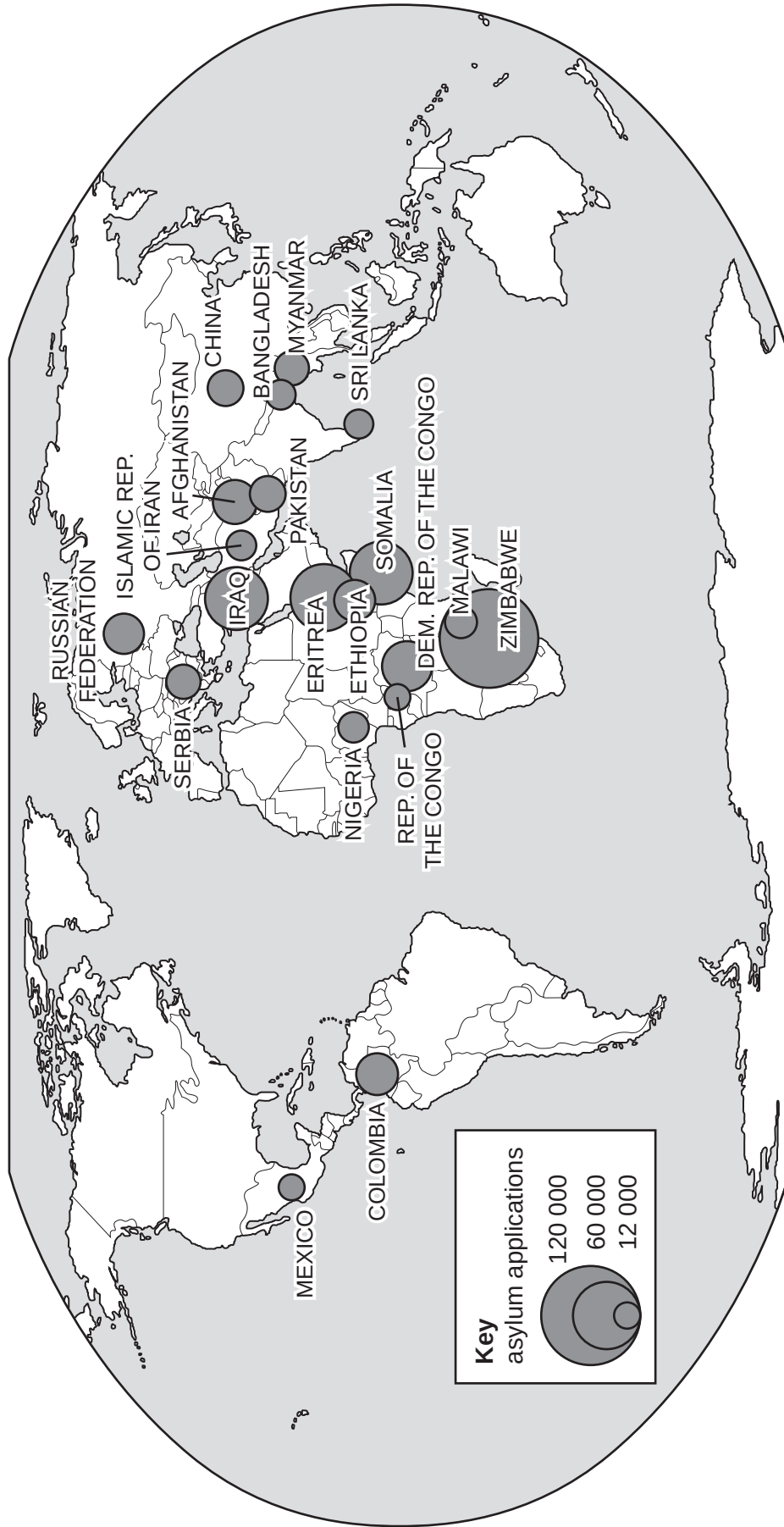

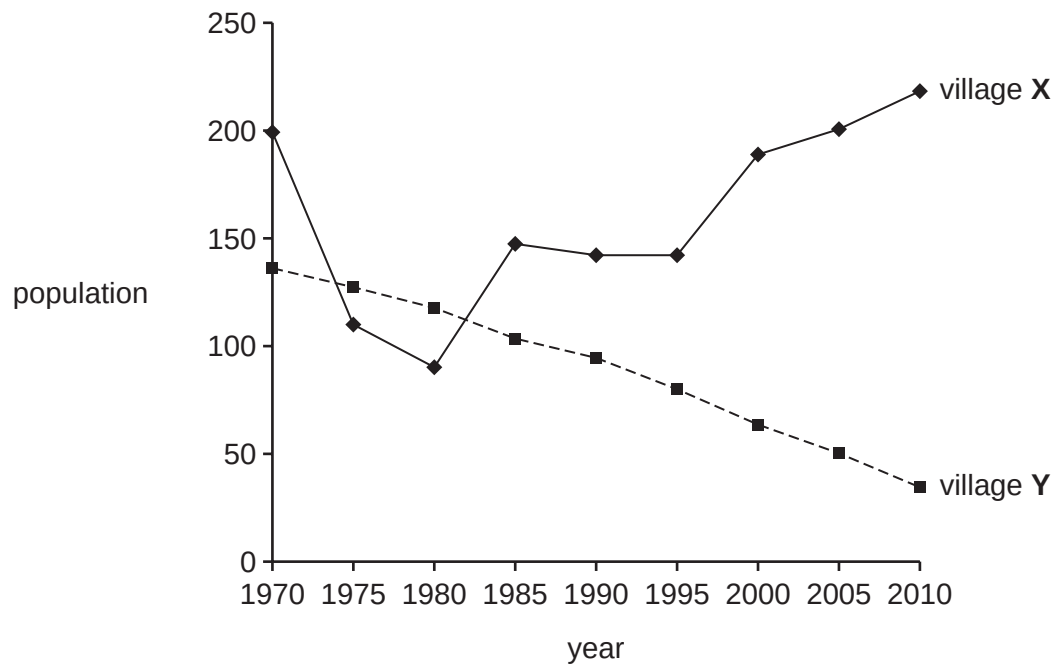
Main countries of origin of international migrants seeing asylum in 2008
