
Candidates should be provided with the maximum choice of topics, but it is accepted that this may not always be possible.

All questions in this paper carry equal marks.





### **Drawing and/or Painting from Observation**

Candidates are required to make a study or studies, using **one** side of a sheet of paper, of **one** of the following. Studies may be larger than life-size and magnifying lenses may be used.

#### **Natural or Man-made Objects**

- 1 A padlock and chain **or** a door bolt **or** a lock mechanism.
- 2 Two vegetables **or** two fruits of contrasting structures, one of them sliced or peeled.
- 3 A length of coloured or decorative ribbon tied in a bow.

## Subjects for working out of doors or from a sheltered position

- 4 Part of a building seen from above or below.
- 5 Some large potted plants placed beneath a window or outside the entrance of a building.
