SENTENCE COMPLETION

Sentence completion questions test your ability to use your vocabulary and understanding of logical composition of the sentence. You need to know not only the dictionary meaning of the word but also the logical and stylistic sense of the sentence.

Sentences are composed of a number of words and ideas that are connected to one another in various ways. You are to figure out how the parts of the sentence are connected. When you understand how these ideas are connected in the sentence, you can say that you really understand the sentence.

CONNECTIONS AND SIGNALS

Most often, some signal words or clues connect the parts of the sentence. These signal words are called "indicators". Let us discuss some high frequency connections and indicators used in the sentence completion section of the test.

CAUSE AND EFFECT:

In this type of sentence, one part of the sentence describes something that causes something in the other part of the sentence.

- (B). The first part of this sentence describes something always win the debate competitionthat is caused or influenced by what's described in the second part. Think over it, "What causes to win the competition?" Only the word "hard" is the correct choice.

The two parts of the sentence are connected by the word "because" that indicates the cause and effect composition of the sentence.

In this type of sentence, one part of the sentence expresses an idea that is opposite to the idea in another part of the sentence.

- It would be surprising to find yourself exhausted by routine exercise.

 —has never been seen clearly, one could logically conclude that it would be —enigmatic.
