Novi sistem kočenja

Prilikom kočenja na putu, obično vozilo oslobađa energiju koja se emituje kao toplota i neiskorištena gubi u vazduhu, te se pokazao interes da se otkrije mehanizam kojim se može sakupiti i iskoristiti ta izgubljena energija.

Otkrivena su dva sistema: jedan je električni i koristi se u hibridnim automobilima a drugi je mehanički i već je u upotrebi kod bolida u Formuli 1.

Međutim, električni sistem vraća 30-35% prikupljene energije dok mehanički način vraća i do 70%.

Savremena auto-industrija je odlučila dati prednost dizajnu kola koji ugrađuje mehanički sistem jer je bolji za okolinu pošto ne koristi štetnu i glomaznu litijumsku bateriju kao električni hibridni model te je tako automobil lakši a i prostor je racionalnije iskorišten.

Prvi testovi već pokazuju da mehanički sistem efikasnije koristi gorivo, smanjuje emitovanje opasnih izduvnih gasova i praktičniji je u proizvodnji automobila.

Vjeruje se da će se za 5 godina otpočeti sa komercijalnom proizvodnjom ovog novog tipa automobila.

Do sredine prošlog vijeka znanje i učenje stranog jezika je bilo obavezan dio elementarnog obrazovanja u školama. Široko rasprostranjeno mišljenje je bilo da time učenici stiču višestruku korist, kao što su razvoj umnih sposobnosti, učenje jednog novog sistema pravila, što je doprinosilo boljem razumijevanju gramatike i pravopisa maternjeg jezika, ali i drugih predmeta. Naravno, time su se otvarale i mogućnosti za upoznavanje drugih zemalja i njihovih običaja i dostignuća iz literature i umjetnosti.

U modernom svijetu znanje stranog jezika je važno zbog ekonomskih razloga, tj. pridobijanja novih klijenata i sklapanja poslova. Opsežna istraživanja su potvrdila da poslovni ljudi lakše sklapaju poslove ako sa klijentima mogu komunicirati na njihovom jeziku, čime indirektno pokazuju da cijene njihovu kulturu i običaje. Osobe koje govore više jezika imaju bolje mogućnosti za posao.

Stanovnici Australije svakodnevno koriste preko 300 jezika u njihovim kućama, razgovorima sa rodbinom, na poslu, čitajući novine ili internet, slušajući vijesti na radiju ili televiziji, itd. Australijska vlada podržava učenje stranih jezika i izdvaja velika sredstva za njihovo izučavanje.

Osamdesetih godina bila je popularna ideja da se uvede i esperanto uz engleski jezik. Esperanto je jednostavan ali kompletan jezik koji se brzo uči te se smatralo da bi se uvođenjem esperanta također popravilo učenje pravopisa i gramatike engleskog jezika.

Na nedavno održanom seminaru o jezicima prevladalo je mišljenje da su osobe koje poznaju i govore još jedan ili više jezika nezamjenjivo blago u australskom društvu i modernoj ekonomiji i veliki stimulans za poslovne i ostale kontakte.
