한국은 휴대전화 사용률이 세계 2위이다. 휴대전화를 가진 사람은 90%가 넘고 이 중 10대가 차지하는 비율은 70% 이상이다. 게다가 휴대전화에 문제가 없음에도 불구하고 사용하지 않고 집에 보관되어 있는 휴대전화는 한 집에 두세 개다.

휴대전화는 학생들이 가장 받고 싶어하는 선물이다. 문자보내기, 사진, 게임, 인터넷, 음악, 전자사전, 교통카드 기능 등도 많이 사용되고 있다. 이 중에서 문자보내기과 게임은 가장 인기가 있는 기능이다. 학생들은 하루에 100~200건의 문자를 보낸다. 또한, 비싼 요금에도 불구하고 인터넷에 접속하는 학생들도 적지 않다. 휴대전화에는 교통카드 기능뿐만 아니라 현금기능까지 있어서 전화요금이 더 많이 나오는데 경제력이 없는 학생 대신 부모님들이 그것을 힘들게 부담하고 있다고 한다. 작고 얇고 새 기능이 추가된 비싼 휴대전화는 10대 학생들에게 가장 많이 팔리고 있다. 휴대전화를 바꾸는 주기가 세계 평균은 2.8년인데 비해 한국 학생들은 거의 1년마다 새 휴대전화로 바꾼다고 한다.
